1, Controller

2, Scope of the Data Processed

When using the main homepage, the Controller may process the following personal data:

Contact Form

First name and surname/entity name.

Company name.

e-mail address.

telephone.

message content.

technical Data

when you visit the website, the following may be automatically processed:

IP-address.

Technical device data.

browser type.

browser language.

cookies and technical logs.

3, Purpose of Processing the Personal Data

Personal data is processed for the purpose of:

processing a contact request.

communicating with a prospective customer or a business partner.

ensuring the functionality and security of the homepage.

protecting the IT infrastructure and preventing system abuse.

fulfilling legal obligations.



4, Legal Basis for Processing

The legal basis for processing the personal data is:

article GDPR
consent of the data subject via the contact form.

article GDPR
legitimate interest of the Controller in:

Ensuring Cybersecurity;
protecting the web infrastructure;
protecting against misuse of forms;
maintaining communication with interested parties.

article GDPR
compliance with legal obligations under European Union law

5, Data Retention Period

Personal data will be retained:

for a maximum of 12 months from the last communication.
or for the period necessary to comply with legal obligations.
or for the duration of the business or contractual relationship.

technical logs and security records may be retained for the period necessary to protect the IT infrastructure and system security.

6, Data Recipients

Personal data may be disclosed to:

a hosting provider with your consent.
IT and security suppliers with your consent.
email service providers with your consent.
legal, tax or regulatory entities with your consent.

The Controller does not provide personal data to third parties for marketing purposes without your separate consent.

7, Data Transfer to Third Countries



in the case of the use of technical or cloud services, data may be transferred outside the European economic area, and the controller will ensure adequate protection mechanisms in accordance with the GDPR.

8, Rights of the Data Subject

The data subject is entitled to:

- request access to personal data.
- request correction of data.
- request deletion of data.
- request restriction of processing.
- to object to processing.
- file a complaint with the supervisory authority.
- withdraw consent to processing.

9, Cookies

The homepage may use technical and analytical cookies to:

- ensure the proper functioning of the site.
- improve user comfort.
- protect system security.
- anonymous traffic analytics.

The user can adjust cookie settings via the cookie bar or browser settings.

10, Security

The Controller takes appropriate technical and organisational measures to protect personal data and IT infrastructure, including:

- SSL/TLS encryption.
- form protection.
- security monitoring.
- data access restrictions.
- basic protection mechanisms against system abuse.
